Histoire

1687, Louis XIV names Monsieur de Beaucastel

“Captain of the village of Courthézon”.

1909, The Perrin family acquires the estate.

1936, Châteauneuf du Pape, the first French AOC.

1950, Jacques Perrin turns to organic farming.

1974, First trials of biodynamic culture.

1989, First vintage of Hommage à Jacques Perrin.

Le vignoble

- 100 hectares (240 acres), in one single plot at the northern limit of the Appellation of Châteauneuf du Pape.
- A unique terroir with rolled pebbles, clay and sand on limestone.
- Cool Microclimate due to the Mistral wind.
- All 13 varieties are grown at Beaucastel.

Hommage à Jacques Perrin

- First vintage in 1989.
- Majority of Mourvèdre. Great ageing potential.
- Only produced in vintages that are great for late ripening varieties (indian summer vintages).
- Very limited production.
- Varieties are vinified separately and blended. after malolactic fermentation.

The quintessence of Château de Beaucastel, Hommage à Jacques Perrin delights us every year, and the 2019 vintage is no exception. To the eye it offers a splendid deep red color, verging on black. Full of power and supremely elegant, the nose is of magnificent aromatic complexity with notes of black fruit and spices that offer all the characteristic expression of Mourvèdre. Perfectly balanced by an incredible freshness, the mouth is eminently elegant with intense and complex aromas of great subtlety, a full, refined texture, subtle tannins of great finesse, and infinite length. A great classic Hommage à Jacques Perrin.
