### TASTING NOTE

A classic, elegant Adelaide Hills Chardonnay with aromas of melon, peaches, and a hint of exotic fruit. Ripe and juicy fruit flavors on the palate are complemented by creamy smooth oak, leading to a long, smooth finish.

### COLOR

Vibrant straw yellow in color.

### ENJOY WITH

Roasted baby spatchcock stuffed with ricotta and herbs, pappardelle with rabbit and white wine sauce, pumpkin or soft cheeses.

### IDEAL DRINKING

Enjoy now.

### WINEMAKERS COMMENT

Fruit is pressed gently via bag press, cold settled, and racked with partial solids. Early fermentation in stainless, then completed in French Oak hogsheads. Regular lees stirring and maturation for eight months adding texture and length to the palate.

### REGION

#### ADELAIDE HILLS

Sourced from well-maintained Vineyards in the cool climate Adelaide Hills region, located in South Australia. Adelaide Hills is renowned for producing crisp, fresh, citrusy Chardonnay. The cool climate of the Adelaide Hills allows the grapes to ripen slowly, allowing more complex flavors to develop, while still maintaining good acid levels and moderate sugar levels in the fruit.
