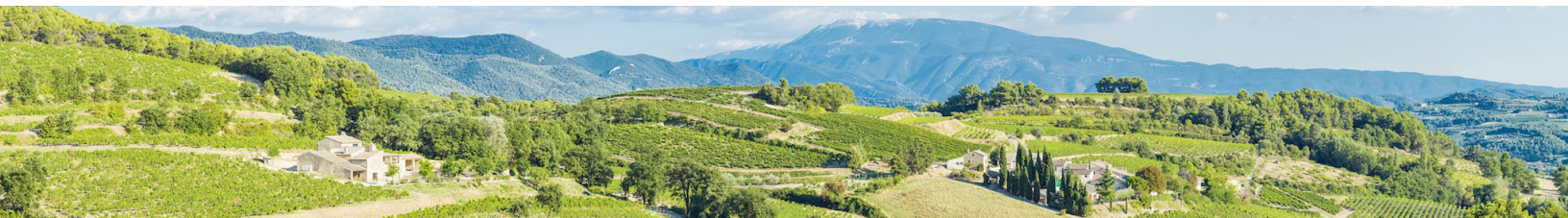


FAMILLE PERRIN

“A sélection parcelleaire from the lieu-dit of the same name, the Perrin Family’s 2012 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Les Chapouins spent five years in their cellars prior to bottling - so yes, the 2012 is the current release. It’s grown on classic galets roulés in the northern sector of the appellation, a blend of Grenache, Mourvèdre and Syrah. A mellow nose of ripe cherries, leather and spice leads the way, followed by a medium to full-bodied wine that’s supple and ready to drink, with flavors that range from black cherries and red plums to more savory nuances of leather, clove and allspice.”
