ABOUT BULLETIN PLACE

Bulletin Place inspired by the historic building site, located along the famous Sydney harbor. Built in 1816, later becoming one of the best known wine houses.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2022 vintage in South Eastern Australia overall was a very high quality vintage with healthy yields. This was due to persistent rainfall events during the early growing season in Winter and Spring, allowing ample soil moisture storages for the warm summer ahead.

WINEMAKING

The fruit is machine harvested at night and upon receipt, the fruit is immediately crushed and destemmed. Fermentation on skins continues for 7 days, then pressed to tank to complete primary fermentation. Upon completion of primary fermentation, the parcels are then racked onto French and American oak staves for Malo-lactic fermentation in tank, then sulphured, and matured for 9 months prior to blending and fining.
